1. Entries

- (a) The Junior Open is open to boys and girls under the age of 18 as at 00.01 on 1st January 2019, i.e. born in any year from and including 2001.
- (b) Entries must be submitted on the official entry form and be accompanied by payment of the entry fee. The entry form must be sent to the Professional's shop, Elie Sports Club, Golf Club Lane, Elie KY9 1AS clearly marked "Junior Open Entry".
- (c) Entries close at 5pm on Friday 12th July 2019. Late entries may be accepted in exceptional circumstances and at the discretion of the Committee.
- (d) Entrants in categories with ages under 18, under 16 and under 14 must hold a current CONGU handicap. Entrants under 12 years may enter without holding a current CONGU handicap.
- (e) Entrants may enter in one category only.

2. Format

- (a) Competitors are requested to register at the Golf House Club Starters Office on arrival and not later than 30 minutes prior to their starting time.
- (b) The Junior Open shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by R&A Rules Limited and the Local Rules of the Golf House Club and Elie Sports Club.
- (c) A player is prohibited from having a caddie during a round. Penalty for Breach of Local Rule: The player gets the general penalty for each hole during which he is helped by a caddie. If the breach happens or continues between two holes, the player gets the general penalty for the next hole.
- (d) Competitors 12 years of age or older as at 00.01 on 1st January 2019 will play one round of 18 holes over Elie Links with trophies awarded to the best gross score in each category.
- (e) Competitors under 12 years of age as at 00.01 on 1st January 2019 will play one round of 18 holes over the Baird Course with trophies awarded to the best gross score in each category.
- (f) Immediately after the round is complete, score cards must be returned to the Professional's shop.

3. Prizes

- (a) Trophies will be presented in each age category as stated on the official entry form.
- (b) Further prizes will be awarded by age category.
- (c) There will be a nearest the pin and long drive competition on both Elie Links and the Baird Course.
- (d) The prize giving will be held in the Golf House Club on completion of the event. All competitors are requested to attend.
- (e) Trophy winners will hold the trophy for one year and are asked to return the trophy to Elie Sports Club at least one week before the 2020 Junior Open.

4. General

- (a) If a competitor acts contrary to the spirit of the game, the Committee will take appropriate action which may include reporting the facts to the competitor's home club or national association. If a competitor is considered to have committed serious misconduct the competitor may be disqualified.
- (b) Parents, guardians and friends are welcome to spectate but are asked to keep to the sides of the fairways and be aware of the group behind.
- (c) Competitors are reminded of the dress regulations of the Golf House Club which includes collared shirts for both boys and girls and shorts with long socks for boys.
